

Elizabeth House Cookham

After the last lockdown, Elizabeth House reopened on September 7th and for the last 8 weeks has successfully and safely operated the Day Centre with two sessions in bubbles of 8 members each working day, under strict COVID-19 guidelines.

With new government restrictions coming into force from 5th November the EH Trustee Board has decided, with regret and reluctance, it will close down its normal operations from that date through to December 2nd. Government guidelines are not clear cut but our duty of care for the health and safety of our members, volunteers and staff, plus the awareness that Covid 19 infections are accelerating in the community, meant we had no alternative but to close down. We fully acknowledge how much our regular members will miss their opportunity for socialising. However, we shall continue to keep contact with those 60/70 members whom we know will benefit by friendly weekly phone calls. We will continue to provide whatever assistance to them we can to meet their needs. All emails and phone calls to EH will be responded to, during lockdown. It is our current intention to reopen Elizabeth House again on December 3rd subject to any revised government guidance. *Chris Harris*
