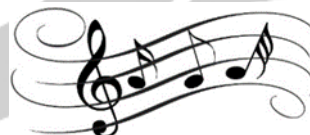

A message from Fr John Regarding the Situation in Afghanistan...

I have been very moved by the situation in Afghanistan over recent days, and I expect you may have been too. Please take an opportunity to say a silent prayer, light a candle, and remember before God the people of Afghanistan. We may each have our own views and prayers for this difficult situation. I think we can all pray for the ordinary people of Afghanistan who may be fearful of what the future may hold, and for those seeking to leave the country in fear of persecution. We can pray for the safe transport home of UK citizens and of those Afghans who have risked their own lives to support British efforts in the country. For myself, I also pray that the new regime, which is likely to be established very shortly, will be moved to take an enlightened view of human rights including access to education for all, and I pray for the positive influence and work of UNICEF and other NGO's in the country.
