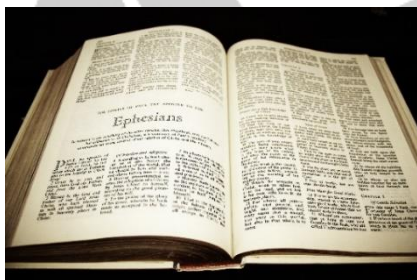
Intinction

To enable the congregation to receive communion in both kinds, we will be intincting the wafers (i.e. dipping them in the wine). This will be done at the point of communion by the priest, who will dip the wafer in the chalice held by a server (or another priest) just as the communicant approaches the priest. If you don't wish for your wafer to be intincted, please approach with your arms crossed. It is recommended that the intincted wafer is consumed immediately, and not taken back to your seat. Whilst we don't feel that this is yet the time to drink from a common cup, we hope that this action will be seen as a further step on the path back to normal. Fr Nick

Trinity Talk Monday, 6th June

Popular speaker Michael Phillips returns on Monday, 6th June to talk on D-Day 6th June 1944: The British and Canadian Landing Sectors. He couldn't have timed it better! Mike will consider the huge logistical challenges faced by the Allies and how they were overcome. We will look at the British and Canadian Sectors codenamed Gold, Juno and Sword Beaches, their defences together with some extraordinary British inventions that helped win the day. There will be stories from the Canadian Military Cemetery at Beny sur Mer, concluding with the action at Pegasus Bridge. After a 25 year career in the London insurance market, former Cookham resident Michael spent 20 years as a tour guide of the D-Day Landing Beaches, gaining a wealth of historical knowledge of the 1944 Normandy Landings. Now retired, he gives informative and entertaining talks with some interesting back stories: presenting facts, examining legends and exposing propaganda.

Trinity Talks are held at Bel and The Dragon in Cookham High Street (usually) on the third Monday of the month and celebrate the talents of people living in Cookham and its environs. These are fund-raising events for Holy Trinity Church. After June the talks take a summer break and return in September.
