SUCCESSFUL CONCRETE POURING

Following on from Mondays Blessings...if you were at the Parish Centre on Wednesday you will have seen some large vehicles that were there all day in connection with work at the church. They were there to pump fast-setting concrete into the vaults, on top of a membrane that was placed carefully over exposed burials. This will enable the contractors to skim the tops of the brick vaults to provide a uniform depth to lay piping for the underfloor heating.

PEW NEWS.

The church reordering project meant that we needed to find new homes or purposes for the 38 Victorian pine pews at Holy Trinity Church. The pews were of varying length, the majority well over 3 meters, too long to be used unaltered in most modern houses. However, as at the beginning of the New Year we have found new homes or new purposes for 33 of the pews. These will now be used as seats in houses as far apart as Sevenoaks, Sheffield and Sidmouth, with some being resized or repurposed for other uses. All being well, it is intended that some will reappear in the church, having been repaired and restored as free-standing benches, leaving just 5 to sell. .To date the pew sales have raised £ 2,500 for the reordering project

For obvious reasons, not least that fact that the remaining 5 unallocated pews are in the open air, albeit under plastic sheeting, we would like to find new homes for this remaining stock as soon as possible. They are offered at a standard price of £50 per pew, "as seen" and without any guarantees of quality.
