Shrove Tuesday Did you know...

- The exact date of Shrove Tuesday changes from year to year. But one thing stays the same – it is always 47 days before Easter Sunday.
- The name comes from the old word 'shriving', which means to listen to someone's sins and forgive them. In Anglo-Saxon England, Christians would go to church on Shrove

Tuesday to confess their sins and clean their soul. In other words, they would be 'shriven'.

- The story goes that pancake races originated way back in 1445, in the town of Olney in Buckinghamshire. A woman was so busy making pancakes that she lost track of time. When she heard the church bells ringing for the Shrove Tuesday Mass, she ran as fast as she could to make it and arrived still carrying her pancake in the pan!
- 52 million eggs are used in the UK alone which is 22 million more than your average day.
- In other countries, Shrove Tuesday has different names. In Germany it's called 'Fastnacht' ('Eve of the Fast') and in Iceland it's called 'Sprengidagur' ('Bursting Day'). In other places it is called 'Mardi Gras', from the French meaning 'Fat Tuesday'. And in many places Mardi Gras also means party time...!
