Update - Cadent Road Closures Access to the Church 30/3-12/4

Church Gate is open, but only accessible via Cookham Bridge, which is open in both directions. You can reach the parish centre but only via the bridge, from the Bucks side, Bourne End. You can drive away along the same route. That's good news for anyone coming from Bourne End, but not so much for those hoping to come via Cookham High Street. Please note that you cannot reach us from Sutton Road or from the High Street. School Lane is open but serves no purpose trying to reach the church. Access is from Bourne End, over Cookham Bridge only. We apologise for inconvenience and are informed that the works will take about two weeks, after which access can return to normal. We are very grateful to our neighbours for their patience during this time and we ask everyone to try and walk where possible.

let your living presence be known among us.

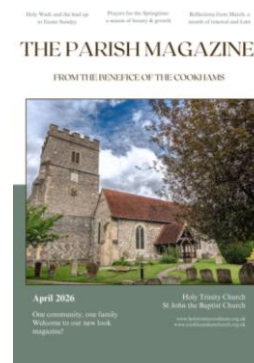
Bring hope where there is sorrow,
